5. Review agency services summaries in relation to the action plan

- Reviewed Immunize Nevada. Carol Luna suggested their services fit into objective 1, strategy 2. Immunize Nevada offers a learning series geared towards health care workers. Immunize Nevada will be added as an



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available resource to the action plan. Carol will send Megan and Amanda information on the learning series that can be added to the list of trainings that Amanda is working on.

- Kayla Vally, NV CHWA, informed that objective 2, strategy 3 is no longer relevant as the pilot study to make CHW services reimbursable with Medicaid is not be moving forward at this time. Kayla said they will try again in 2 years. Regarding objective 2, strategy 2 for internship opportunities, Kayla informed in the north CHWA partners with the employer to give students credit going through their program. However, it is not the same in southern Nevada where they are trying to find field placement opportunities. Kayla and Lori Ann Malina-Lovell discussed their meeting about potential placement options in early intervention playgroups. Part C will be added as an available resource.
- In reviewing the 2 agency service summaries, we identified the process of cross-walking their services to the action plan was a time-consuming process & that our time in the subcommittee meeting would be better served if everyone did their own crosswalk for their agencies & brought that back to the next subcommittee meeting.
- Motion accepted and carried to update the action plan as discussed to add Immunize Nevada and Part C as available resources and remove the pilot study as a strategy.
