WHAT IS THE CENSUS?

The census is an official count of the U.S. population. Unfortunately, many people do not take the census, causing an undercount. Children under five are the age group most likely to be left out of the census count.

HOW DOES THIS HELP KIDS?

The census tells the government how much money to give to states for things like hospitals, schools, and community programs. Having the right count of people in our state means more money for our children.

HOW IS CENSUS DATA USED?

Your personal information is confidential and cannot be shared with any government entity. The federal, state and local governments all use census data to make policy decisions related to funding.
