Nevada Assembly Bill 114 has created a need for additional ECAC representatives including:

- (1) one member who is a representative of the Division of Public and Behavioral Health of the Department of Health and Human Services whose duties include responsibility for maternal, child and adolescent health;
- (2) one member who is a representative of the Program for Child Care and Development in the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services of the Department;
- (3) one member who is a representative of a public school who works with pupils in kindergarten through grade 3;
- (4) one member who is a representative of a tribal organization;
- (5) at least one member who is a parent or guardian of a child less than 8 years
