Nevada Assembly Bill 114 has created a need for additional ECAC representatives including:

- One member who is a representative of a public school who works with pupils in kindergarten through grade 3;
- One member who is a representative of a tribal organization;
- At least one member who is a parent or guardian of a child less than 8 years
