

Statement of Best Practices for Data Collection Data and Evaluation Subcommittee

The Data and Evaluation Subcommittee focuses on upholding responsible and transparent data practices with a focus on prioritizing Nevada's families, inclusion and cultural appropriateness, and ensuring collection of data is both ethical and private.

• Purpose-Driven Data:

Data should be collected with a clear purpose and aligned to program objectives.

• Self-Identification:

Prioritize self-reported demographic data (gender, race, ethnicity, Sexual Orientation, Gender Identity) to ensure representation and inclusivity, when applicable.

• Ethical Storage and Security:

Access to data is restricted to authorized personnel to safeguard privacy.

• Granularity and Confidentiality:

Data is aggregated to ensure confidentiality, pursuing granularity only when it improves analysis.

• Transparent Communication:

Use visualizations and explanatory text to communicate data clearly and effectively to all stakeholders, including but not limited to parents, partnering agencies and the public.

• Continuous Improvement:

Strive to continuously refine data practices through feedback, evolving methodologies, and adherence to best practices.
