5. Early Learning Data and Reporting System (ELDRS) Presentation (Discussion and Review)

The DBDriven team shared progress of the QRIS dashboard with the Subcommittee, as well as discussing the infrastructure of an ECIDS, Vulnerable and Underserved Population and the Data Dictionary collaboration with ELDRS. Matthew Silver, Management Analyst 2, Nevada Department of Education Matthew Hoffman, Education Programs Professional, Nevada Department of Education DBDriven Guest Speakers

- Mathew Hoffman introduced the data reporting system and covered topics such as Early Learning Reporting and Data System (ELDRS), QStar Report, Demographics Report, Vulnerable Population Data Dictionary, ELDRS Portal for reports in development.
 - o Provides filtering for data depending on what a parent or Early Childhood Systems worker is looking for
 - o First Early Childhood System all in one database instead of spreading across multiple platforms
 - o Currently just NV!PK, extending out to include all Early Childhood age groups
- Matthew Hoffman introduced Craig of DBDriven to continue presentation
- Craig described howe the data works, and showed examples from other agencies and was able to show the members how to use the database.
- Amanda Haboush Deloye suggested a way to research data without sorting through all if the tables?
- Craig responded that yes there is a way to search, and showed various examples of search tools
- Amanda Haboush-Deloye asked how we would be made aware of system or data updates?
- Craig responded that it would depend on who is doing the updates, time wise- faster to have OELD or NDE do it
- Matthew Hoffman described that a lot of times it is hard to know what the data is telling us
- Marty Elquist asked the Subcommittee if this tool should be shared with the entire ECAC
- Ashley Dines agreed





- Kate Pflueghoft expressed concern to make sure that we need to know what it will look like and what it includes before we bring it to everyone
- Matthew Hoffman described that we could make it a high priority to get this available to be the exact resource we would want to be to be useful for all subcommittees
- Paulo Dorado mentioned not doing things quickly to just get them done but to do it correctly, so it is useable data
- Anna Binder and Marty Elquist express their thoughts on sharing with he group as they may have insight or ideas to add as we are still tying loose ends, as well as shoeing how far we have come.
- Anna Binder suggests Marty Elquist and Amanda Haboush-Deloye set up meetings offline and figure out the technicalities, then bring it back to our meeting in March

- **6. Top Data Points for a "Snapshot" of the Early Childhood System** (For Discussion and Possible Action) The committee discussed the top data points to use as a snapshot of the "health" of the early childhood system. Marty Elquist and Amanda Haboush-Deloye, Subcommittee Co-Chairs
- Marty Elquist described that this came from Dr. Linda Young asking if we had top points for the health of the Early Childhood System at the last General ECAC meeting, requested thoughts from the Subcommittee
- Kate Pflueghoft suggested bringing this to other groups, so we get the whole picture
- Amanda Haboush-Deloye mentioned having a lot of data doesn't make it the BEST data, need to gather evidence from other agencies.
- Anna Binder suggests bringing the report of this is the best data we have, this is what we are missing and have ECAC council lead us to how to move forward.
- Marty described that the priority could be making sure we have the data to answer the questions that we have
- Kate Pflueghoft suggested sending out surveys "What would be the data needed to describe the Early Childhood Systems in Nevada" having the agencies write out what their questions are, so we can get the snapshot of the entire system as a whole.
- Marty Elquist asked Tiffany Olivas if we could use the HRSA groups to respond to the Survey and get a broad idea from their diverse perspectives, Tiffany Olivas agreed
- Marty Elquist then asked who would responsible be creating the survey
- Amanda Haboush Deloye suggests Smriti Neupane once she returns can help with the Survey. Survey steps::
 - One survey, State Questions, Ask if the data is pertinent, then repeat for each questions with a space available for what they feel we missed. History and vision of the research to start with, rank results from survey to identify priority.
- Sabrina Jones to add to workplan as action step: Creating a survey to disseminate by sector to get feedback on our research question to share and identify data and prioritize data.
