 - April is First Five Nevada Community Outreach event @ CSN in Las Vegas
 - Focused in 2025 to allow parents to use their voice as they have been working on doing within the Leadership program,

- Denise Tanata let members know that the Report was sent to Executive Leaders and again shared what the First 5 Nevada website is meant for and the Family Resource Center that they are striving to be. They also help families with finding if they are qualified for any of the program's here in Nevada such as Child Care subsidy and Government programs such as TANF.
- Kathy Yoder Bass asked where to send parents in regard to Child Care Subsidy since Las Vegas Urban League is not helping and families are frustrated.
- Denise Tanata described that First Five helps find the resources, but doesn't help with applications as of now
